### PLEASE BE ADVISED

We are only accepting a maximum of 15 vendors for each market. Spots will be filled on a first come first served basis.

All Vendors must read and follow the Public Safety Guidelines provided to them by the Northwest Farmers' Market. A copy of the guidelines must be brought with the vendor to each market.

Market staff will have a sanitizing and screening station set up at the market entrance. Vendors are required to provide PPE and sanitizer for themselves and their booth.

Vendors selling food, both preprepared and prepared on-site, must sign an additional waiver form inlcuded with this package Booth location will be asigned based on the description of set-up provided by vendors. Additional tables or chairs will not be provided unless prior arrangements have been made with the market manager.

There are no refunds for any missed markets

In addition to our advertising, vendors are encouraged to advertise their attendance at our markets.

# **WAIVER FOR FOOD VENDORS**

	I understand that the Northwestern Health Unit may prohibit vendors from attending the market if they see that they are not following proper food safety protocols and practices. All contact regarding market eligibilty will be between the vendor and the local public health inspector.
	I agree to hold the Northwest Farmers Market, the Sioux Lookout Chamber of Commerce, the Sioux Lookout Travel Information Centre and each organizations staff members unresponsible for your inability to attend the market should the Northwestern Health Unit's Public Health Inspectors find that you are not following all of the protocols required or not meeting the proper standards. No refund will be issued should the Northwestern Health Unit deem your food items unfit to sell at the market and prohibit you from attending.
	I understand that I am expected to follow all regulations and guidelines set out by the Northwestern Health Unit and the Ontario Food Premises Regulation under the Ontario Health Protection and Promotion Act as well as the Ontario Food Safety and Quality Act. It is the Vendor's responsibilty to ensure they are meeting these standards and are in good standing. The Northwest Farmers Market and Sioux Lookout Chamber of Commerce will not be responsible for the education of the vendors.
